

<u>Outwood Post 16 Centre – Careers Programme – 2023-2024 Academic Year</u>

At Outwood Post 16 Centre, development for student progression is at the heart of our curriculum as Post 16 bridges the transition between aspiration and realisation of student potential. High quality advice and guidance supports students to connect opportunities with their potential, to ensure they make informed and realistic decisions regarding their post-18 destination. The curriculum prepares students for future success in education, employment or training through providing; unbiased information to all our students about their potential next steps; high quality, up-to-date local, regional and nationally relevant careers guidance. Students develop skills, attitudes and values through positive engagement and experiential learning in enrichment activities and/or work experience, preparing them for employment, training or progression to higher study. Students have a number of fulfilling opportunities for good quality and meaningful encounters with the world of work through industry placement, collaborative project work and non-qualification activities. Students are signposted to high quality impartial careers guidance, which enables all students to make informed decisions to facilitate progress and take ownership of their post-18 destination.

Our Senior Leadership Team, Guidance Tutors and Support Staff work with students to:-

- \checkmark Ensure all students have impartial careers advice and guidance
- ✓ Provide opportunities for students to research potential post-18 progression pathways
- ✓ Enhance their employability skills and encourage them to 'stand out from the crowd'
- ✓ Provide support, advice and guidance on their university, apprenticeship, employment or training application
- ✓ Ensure they are fully prepared for interviews for their post-18 destination
- ✓ Enhance student links with the world of work & alumni students

The extensive careers programme offered to all our students has been developed in line with The Gatsby Benchmarks and CDI Framework guidance.
